

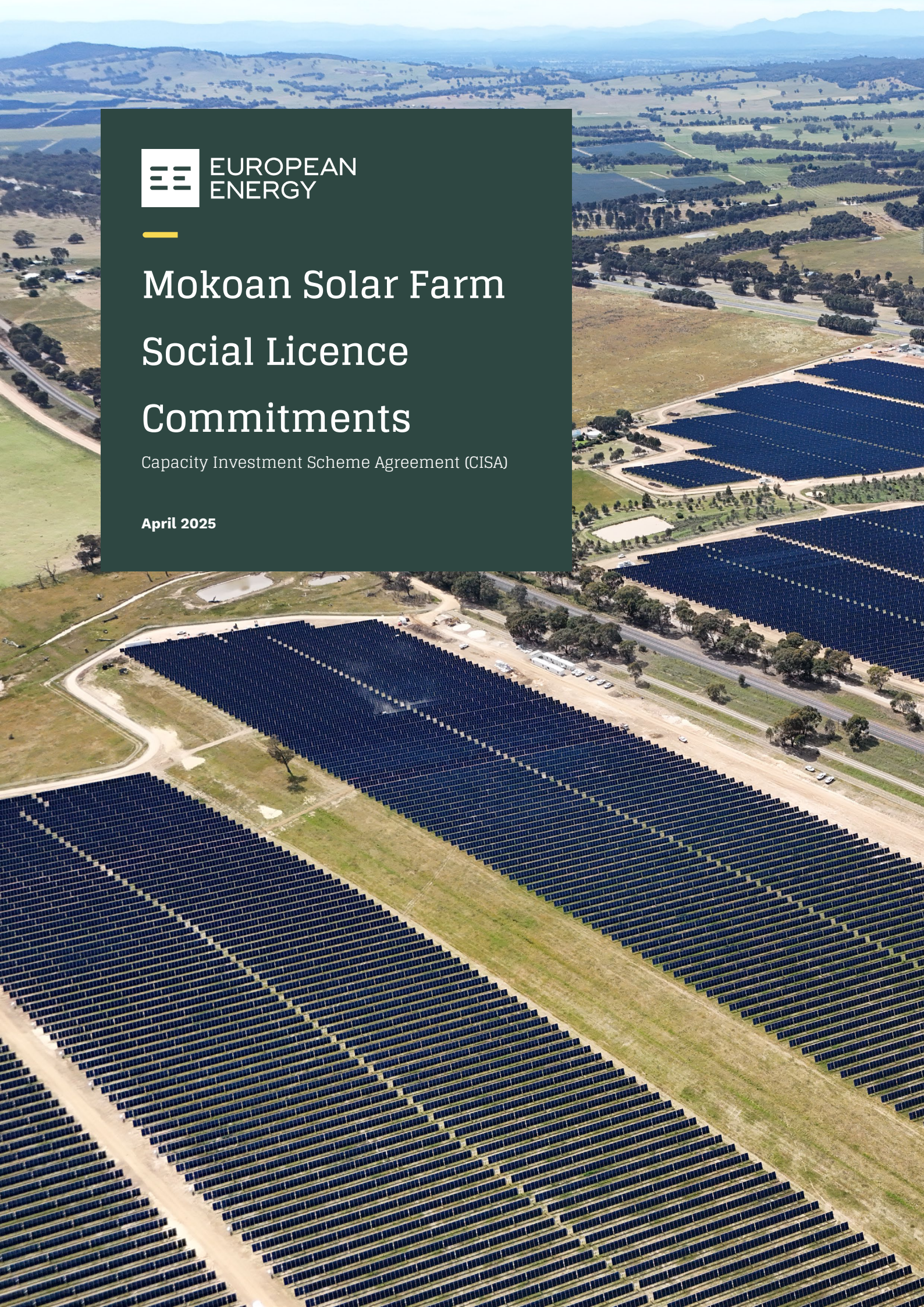

Mokoan Solar Farm Social Licence Commitments

Capacity Investment Scheme Agreement (CISA)

Social Licence Commitments – Mokoan Solar Farm

Mokoan Solar Farm was selected as part of the Australian Government's Capacity Investment Scheme, which encourages new renewable energy projects by providing long-term revenue security to support investment certainty.

Under this agreement, Mokoan Solar Farm has committed to the Social Licence Commitments outlined below, which will provide support to the local community and First Nations groups, and promote local employment and local content.

Social Licence Commitment	Description
Shared community benefits commitments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A \$345,000 Community Benefit Fund that will spend \$11,500 on average from June 2025 to June 2055 providing annual funding grants to community stakeholders for social and environmental purposes.
First Nations Commitments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have committed \$7,500 during the first five years of operation (\$1,500 per annum on average from June 2025 to June 2030) to support First Nations businesses and encourage participation on the Mokoan site as well as our other projects on Yorta Yorta Country. A \$40,000 First Nations Benefit Fund will spend \$5,000 on average from June 2025 to June 2033. Through our development of a Memorandum of Understanding with the Yorta Yorta Nation Aboriginal Corporation (YYNAC) and local First Nations organisations, EE will co-design initiatives that will benefit First Nations people in these communities, which may include education and training, land management and cultural revitalisation.
Commitments to Local employment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have committed \$20,000 to be spent over 2 years (\$10,000 on average) to fund initiatives to encourage further local participation on the Mokoan site as well as our other projects in the same region. Examples of activities associated with this commitment include distributing project opportunities, organising supplier nights or providing general support to local businesses in the region.
Commitments related to use of Local Content	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> \$61,394,712 committed to local content during construction of the project. \$35,970,000 committed to local content during operation of the project. <p>Detail of the breakdown of local content use has been withheld due to commercial sensitivities.</p>
