Summary

- Approx. 35 to 40 turbines
- Turbine heights of up to 250 metres
- If approved, provide power for up to 250,000 homes or 280 MW.



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We are currently early in the development process. The project would consist of turbines, a substation and a new connection to the existing 220kV Kerang–Bendigo transmission line, which will be designed to co-exist with ongoing farming activities. 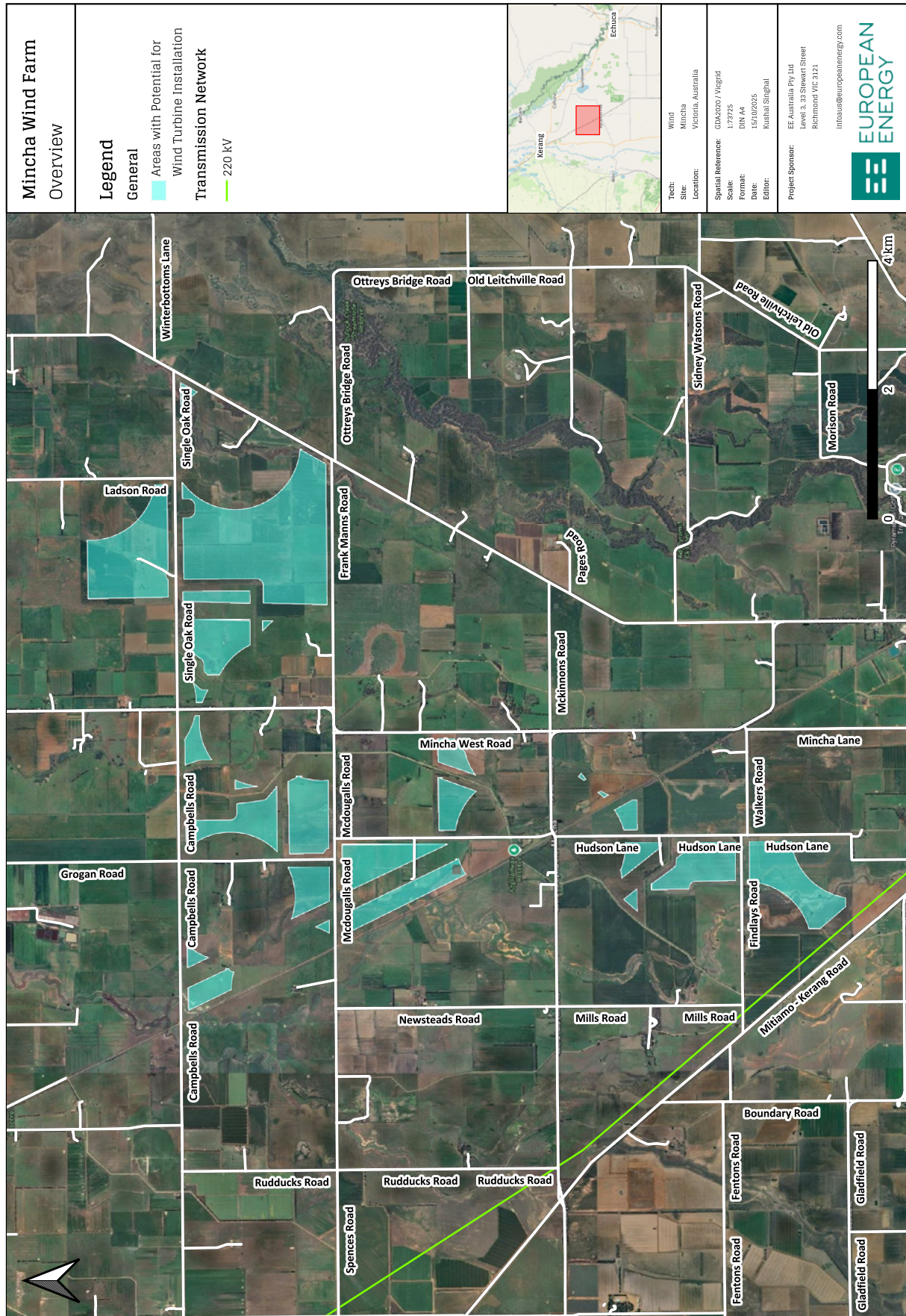
