The Bullyard Renewable Energy Project is a 97 MW solar farm, with plans to potentially add a battery energy storage system. Located 44 km west of Bundaberg, Queensland, the project received approval in 2024. Construction will start mid-2026 and is expected to take 6-12 months.

Community benefits funding is available for community priorities, including environmental, social, infrastructure, sponsorships, and donations. The project will create about 150 jobs during construction, 8-10 ongoing roles for operations and maintenance, and support local procurement.


